Position Summary:

The Waterton Gas Complex is currently looking for a safety-oriented individual to fill an operations role for their high-pressure sour gas field situated southwest of Pincher Creek, Alberta. Reporting to the Field Foreman, the Production Maintenance Operator will be responsible to provide operational support to the Asset, including monitoring, troubleshooting, and safe operation of the wells, gathering systems, and compressor stations.

The Production Maintenance Operator will provide direct guidance and support to operating staff and contractors to consistently meet or exceed expectations in the following areas: health and safety, production, operating costs, corporate values, environment, training, regulation, and emergency response while in care and control of the field. We offer unique opportunities for self-starting individuals to have material impact on the shaping and success of our company.

Key Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the safe operation and routine maintenance of 70 sour gas wells, 11 field compressors, and 3 large compressor stations.
- Responsible for isolation and permitting activities in a large industrial setting.
- Routine pipeline maintenance (pigging, batching, chemical injection drawdowns, pump maintenance)
- Must meet the requirements of WHMIS, ABSA, and ASME codes as required.
- Must follow and apply the site's safe work procedures.
- Must be able to take and direct calls from the public regarding the site's activities. Our interactions with the community are critical to our business.
- Must be prepared to respond to an emergency and follow the site's emergency response plan.
- Support and participate in monthly safety meetings
- Assist in environmental reporting (flared gas, waste manifests, D60)
- Submit production in Prodview
- Submit notifications in Maximo for corrective work, and preventative maintenance compliance.
- Supervising or coordinating complex jobs (TA, compressor overhauls, pipeline digs, internal pipeline inspections)
- Assist with Management of Change Requests (MOC)
- Reporting all personal, environmental, and unsafe conditions
- Travel will be required on unmaintained roads in inclement weather

Education and Work Experience:

- Minimum of 3 years operations experience in sour gas processing field required.
- Experience with injection pumps, plunger lifts, screw compression etc., and a good understanding of sour gas process.
- Technical diploma or Journeyman Certificate in a related discipline would be an asset.
- Valid 5th Class driver's license and clean drivers abstract is required.
- Ability to operate UTV, fork lift, and skid steer.
- Current certification in H2S alive, First Aid, WHIMIS, TDG is preferred.
- Demonstrated ability to adapt to process changes and modifications.
- Demonstrated computer literacy and knowledge of automated operations systems.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Proven analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Work well with others in a fast-paced environment.
- Comply with all training requirements and understand all practices and procedures.
- Ability to work overtime and respond off hours as part of an "On Call" rotation.
