**Position Summary:**

The planner role is critical to the effective productivity of the maintenance delivery team. The mechanical planner will make preliminary diagnoses of observe problems and determine the scope of activity required to return the equipment back into service. Packages the work with the tasks, materials and services to effectively complete the repair.

**Key Responsibilities:**

- Develop job specific plans for corrective maintenance, preventative maintenance, capital projects, equipment and piping scope including estimating/linking of individual tasks and work package folders with execution details
- Identify steps on the work order based on specifications/procedures and planning practices
- Scope out each job through site visits, discussion and/or meetings with relevant stakeholders in order to ascertain required level of planning details and documentation appropriate for each individual job
- Identify parts, rentals and services required to do the job and initiate the ordering process
- Liaise with offsite vendors, collect quotes/discuss schedules and set up requisitions
- Act as liaison with Operations, Engineering and other key stakeholders to review and validate scope of work requested through notifications
- Develop, Update and maintain equipment task lists for future planning/estimating requirements

- Minimum Ten (10) Year Industry experience with a certified Journeyman status in Millwright, heavy duty mechanic, pipefitter or welding trades
- Experience in planning for an Industrial Plant setting
- Experience with repair methods, specific to sour gas piping and equipment

- Ability to read/interpret piping and instrumentation diagrams, process flow diagrams, piping ISO's and familiarity with welding procedures/codes
